Aromas of apricot, citrus and honeysuckle, layered with stoned fruits, toast, hazelnuts and vanilla.	
<b>Estancia</b>	40
2005 Chardonnay Pinnacles Ranches, Monterey, CA	
Aroma of pear, passion fruit and fig, hazelnut, lychee nut and vanillin. Subtle nuances of oak.	
<b>Jordan</b>	73
2004 Chardonnay, Russian River Valley, CA	
Brimming with fruit flavor and elegance, a buttery toastiness from the oak and hazelnut and citrus flavors.

2002 Barrel Fermented Chardonnay, Central Valley, CA Mix of mandarin orange, fruit cocktail, ripe pear and earthy citrus shadings, buttery pear aftertaste.

2004 Chardonnay, Sonoma County, CA Ripe pear, honey, fig and apricot, pretty touch of vanilla and butterscotch. WS: 88 points!	
<b>Louis Jadot</b>	62
2004 Pouilly-Fuissé, Burgundy, France Fruit flavors with notes of melon and minerals, gently touched with oak, ending in a fresh, silky finish.	
<b>Louis Jadot</b>	88
2002 Puligny Montrachet, Burgundy, France Subtle with mineral character, on the palate with ripe, rich fruit. Full-bodied and pleasantly oaky; smoke and toasted aromas. Long finish. WS: 93 points!	
<b>Louis Latour</b>	34
2005 Ardèche Chardonnay, France Golden colored with light green reflection, complex aromas of honey and exotic fruits.	
<b>Louis Latour</b>	48
2005 Chablis, Burgundy, France Intense fresh fruit aromas and mineral hints. Crisp finish pronounced by ripe fruit characteristics.	
<b>Errazuriz</b>	44
2002 Wild Ferment Chardonnay, Casablanca Valley, Chile Mango, pineapple, fig and pie crust flavors and mineral spine. An elegant end with lovely flavors. WS: 88 points!

2004 Catena Chardonnay, Mendoza, Argentina Pear, fig, dried pineapple and honeysuckle, modest toast. Lively finish lets the fruit take an encore. WS: 88 points!

2004 Chardonnay, Victoria, Australia Aromas of nectarine, peach and melon; on the palate a crisp natural acidity. Creamy mouth feel, long finish. WS: 89 points!

2004 Diamond Sauvignon Blanc, Napa County, CA Aromas of citrus and melon, a little grassy. Well balanced with a good finish.

2005 Private Selection Sauvignon Blanc, Central Coast, CA Bright lemon, lime, grapefruit and apple aromas and zesty herbal notes; ripe citrus character, mineral finish.	
<b>Simi</b>	42
2005 Sauvignon Blanc, Sonoma County, CA Grapefruit, lemon and orange blossoms and notes of lemon grass and mineral notes.	
<b>de Ladoucette</b>	65
2004 Comte Lafond Sancerre, Loire Valley, France Lemon verbena aroma, palate of straw, wet stones, lemon cream and citrus peel. Long, creamy finish. WS: 89 points!

2003 La Moynerie Pouilly-Fumé, Loire Valley, France Limestone with flavors of lemon curd, smoke and blanched almond. Long finish. WS: 91 points!

2005 Grüner Veltliner, Kamptal, Austria Plenty of citrus and gooseberry flavors, with some nice mineral notes.	

## Rosé

2005 White Zinfandel, Central Coast, CA Strawberry and watermelon aromas hinting of sweetness and finishing with a good, crisp balance.	
<b>Château d'Aqueria</b>	40
2004 Tavel Rosé, Rhône Valley, France Raspberry flavors, fruit intensity and fresh peppery notes; clean, refreshing acidity and a long, dry finish.	

## Cabernet Sauvignon

2003 Cabernet Sauvignon, Alexander Valley, CA Aromas of black cherry, plum, and with spicy elements that include vanilla bean, black pepper and cedar. WS: 88 points!	
<b>Columbia Crest</b>	27
2003 Two Wines Cab. Sauv., Columbia Valley, Washington Minimally oaked with slight cherry and blueberry aromas throughout. Lingering finish with hints of cocoa.	
<b>Far Niente</b>	250
1999 Cabernet Sauvignon, Napa Valley Spice, mineral, herb, olive and currant flavors shaded by light oak. WS: 88 points!	
<b>J. Lohr</b>	43
2004 Seven Oaks Cabernet Sauvignon, Paso Robles, CA Cherry fruit aromas with hints of licorice and marzipan and spicy, vanilla oak. Soft tannins, lingering finish.	
<b>Jordan</b>	110
2002 Cabernet Sauvignon, Sonoma County, CA An herbal style, with ripe, smooth currant, herb, green olive and sage notes. WS: 88 points!	
<b>Silver Oak</b>	140
2001 Cabernet Sauvignon, Alexander Valley, CA Aromas of dill, macaroon and coconut fold in nicely with a rich band of currant, plum and black cherry fruit. Ending with firm, chewy tannins. WS: 89 points!

2003 Cabernet Sauvignon, Alexander Valley, CA Cassis and blackberry with hints of leather accompanied by notes of dried herbs and vanilla.

2003 Cabernet Sauvignon, Sonoma County, CA Aromas of mocha, currant, dill and herb. WS: 90 points!	
<b>Antinori</b>	190
2001 Solaia, Tuscany, Italy Coffee and blackberry character. Full-bodied, with velvety tannins, loads of fruit and excellent wood. Long finish. WS: 93 points!	
<b>Tenuta San Guido</b>	320
2001 Bolgheri Sassicaia, Tuscany, Italy Aromas of summer fruits and hints of cream. Then turns to dried Provençal herbs, such as rosemary. Full-bodied, with sleek, refined tannins and a silky finish. WS: 94 points!	
<b>Concha y Toro</b>	130
2004 Don Melchor, Puento Alto, Chile Nose of currant confiture and cocoa powder, sports dark fig, currant and blackberry fruit layered with loam, cedar, tobacco, mineral and coffee. Long finish.	
<b>Terrazas de los Andes</b>	40
2004 Cabernet Sauvignon Reserva, Mendoza, Argentina Coconut and vanilla toast, blackberry, fig and mocha flavors. Suave, creamy fruit on the finish. WS: 90 points!

2002 Merlot, Napa Valley, CA Aromas of intense black currant and blackberry and flavors with hints of herbs, black olives, and dark red and black fruit.

2002 Two Wines Merlot, Columbia Valley, Washington Intensely fruity with aromas and flavors of blackberry and raspberry. Cocoa and spice in a velvety finish

2003 Merlot, Columbia Valley, Washington Tart and chewy, with a juicy core of currant and herb, finishing with a fresh herb note.

2004 Diamond Merlot, California Tasty, with huckleberry pie, French vanilla notes and a firm cedary finish.

2002 Los Osos Merlot, Paso Robles, CA Blueberry and cherry fruit aromas and tar and anise spice from the oak. Subtle body and finish.

Zesty berry, cherry and spicy nuances. Currant and herbal aromas. Mildly tannic. WS: 88 points!

Vintner's Cuvée XXIX Zinfandel, California  
Cherry and raspberry fruit with hints of black pepper and spice.

## Pinot Noir

2005 Pinot Noir Pinnacles Ranches, Monterey, CA  
Flavors of bright cherry and dark fruits. Velvety tannins with hints of minerals. Lingering finish.
- Foley** 68  
2004 Pinot Noir, Santa Rita Hills, CA  
Wild berry, blueberry, mineral, sage and cedar. Nice tannins and long finish. WS: 88 points!
- Francis Coppola** 54  
2005 Silver Label Pinot Noir, Monterey County, CA  
Straightforward plum, black cherry, cinnamon and nutmeg notes are tasty, finishing with a wood flavor.

## Syrah/Petite Syrah

- Columbia Crest** 27  
2003 Two Wines Shiraz, Columbia Valley, Washington  
Ripe fruits, black cherry and white pepper with hints of strawberry. Supple finish.
- Stags' Leap** 83  
2003 Petite Syrah, Napa Valley, CA  
Blackberries, red currants, cut hay, and burnt oranges flavors. On the palate bitter chocolate, French vanilla, and raspberries.
- Greg Norman** 40  
2004 Shiraz, Limestone Coast, Australia  
Aromas of dark plum, black cherry and spice with ripe cherry flavors and spicy oak. Supple tannins, long finish. WS: 88 points!

2002 Magnificat 'Meritage', Napa Valley, CA  
Aromas of dark cherry, cassis and plum with hints of chocolate, toast and tobacco.
- Opus One** 290  
2002, Napa Valley, CA  
Ripe cherry and plum turn austere, dry and tannic on the palate.
- Château l'Enclos** 95  
2001 Pomerol, Bordeaux, France  
Aromas of plums, toasted oak and tobacco. With fresh acidity and a balanced, tannic finish. WS: 88 points!
- Château Lynch Bages** 200  
2003 Cinquième Cru Classé, Pauillac, France  
Silky, refined tannins and delicate fruit. Full-bodied, with chewy tannins and a lovely long, textured finish. WS: 93 points!

## Bordeaux & Bordeaux Style

**Almaviva** 160  
2002 , Puento Alto, Chile  
Black currant, coffee, bittersweet cocoa, loam and toast aromas and ripe tannins. Big finish with dark fruit and tar. WS: 93 points!

## Malbec

**Achával Ferrer** 66  
2002 Quimera, Mendoza, Argentina  
Boysenberry and raspberry compote flavors, followed by a live-wire minerally tang. WS: 91 points!

**Catena Zapata** 40  
2004 Malbec, Mendoza, Argentina  
Blackberry fruit with spicy black pepper notes, ripe plum and chocolate flavors. Aromas of black currant and cassis.

## Other Reds

**Château Mont-Redon** 75  
2003 Châteauneuf-du-Pape, Rhône Valley, France  
Flavors of dark cherry, red berries and pepper with notes of chocolate and citrus peel. Long finish. WS: 89 points!

**Louis Latour** 53  
2004 Fleurie Les Garans, Burgundy, France  
Smell of sweet fruits, flowers and berry. On the palate lots of strawberry, forest fruit, cherry and some cinnamon.

**E. Guigal** 120  
1997 Hermitage Rouge, Côtes du Rhône, France  
Spices, red berries and delicate oak flavors. Aromas of blackcurrant buds and vanilla. A spicy finish with liquorice.

**Ruffino** 45  
2001 Santedame Chianti Classico, Tuscany, Italy  
Fruity flavors of cherry, raspberry and a blend of spices, vanilla, liquorices and coffee.

**Marqués de Cáceres** 58  
1998 Reserva, Rioja, Spain  
Cherry, vanilla and a sweet touch of spice. Intense flavors of black fruits and soft tannins. WS: 88 points!

2002 Late Harvest ½-Bottle 0.375l, Monterey County, CA  
With modest orange, citrus and pine scents that end with sugary dried pineapple flavors.

**Pavois d'Or** 30  
2004 Sauternes ½-Bottle 0.375l, Bordeaux, France  
Yellow-gold color. Aromas of spice and honey with dried apricot.
